Meet some of our financial aid recipients



Ms Shilpa Batra, a single mother of two, has always been passionate about educating women and children. With a deep interest in public administration, environment, and land reforms, she was determined to achieve her goal of "public welfare using education as a medium" through technology, strategic research, and planning.

Based on her scores in the admissions process and her financial need, she was recommended for financial aid. To ensure her commitment to public policy. she was assigned to an academic team member to develop a research output on education policy. Finally, based on the quality of that output, she was awarded a 100% scholarship.

Following her academic engagement with ISPP, Shilpa is currently serving as a Senior Consultant with EY for Government and Public Sector Services.

Mr Chinmay Dandekar, an engineer from Mumbai, shifted his focus from UPSC exams to public policy education. He discovered ISPP, affiliated with CCS and connected with renowned mentors, which transformed his understanding of India's landscape. ISPP's network connected him with influential figures in the field, and a generous scholarship motivated his transformative journey, despite his modest background and being the first in his family to study outside Maharashtra.



ISPP's Impact

The last 4.5 years



In line with our vision, ISPP offers five key academic programmes:

- 1. Post Graduate Programme in Policy, Design & Management: ISPP's flagship 1-year course, currently in its fifth year with a batch of 49 scholars.
- 2.LokNeeti: Targeted at working professionals, this 4-month hybrid programme is an intensive capsule course on the essentials of public policy.
- 3. Executive education programmes: These are customised to meet specific corporate and government officials' training requirements.
- 4. Public Policy for Young Professionals: A 21-hour Massive Open Online Course on Public Policy designed in partnership with Larsen & Toubro Edutech for young professionals.
- 5. Knowledge partnership with Capacity Building Commission (GoI): A research and training collaboration with the Capacity Building Commission for Mission Karmayogi, Gol's capacitybuilding initiative for civil servants. Along with developing capacity-building modules, ISPP's Case Study Centre is working closely with the Commission to develop cutting-edge public policy case studies for training civil servants.






WELCOMING THE CLASS OF 2024






The engagement will serve as a synergistic relationship between stakeholders of Indian public policy landscape and the new-age policy professionals in the making.




UPCOMING PROGRAMME IN EXECUTIVE EDUCATION -UNDERSTANDING GOVERNMENT

ISPP is set to launch a new Executive education programme titled "Understanding Government" - designed to address critical challenges that are often faced when working with the government. Over two days, participants will cover four courses that begin with an 'Introduction to Indian public policymaking' and cover various aspects ranging from governance to policy-making and building effective partnerships with the government. The programme has been designed by individuals who have served in the government and have participated extensively in policymaking and governance processes. They have brought together their tremendous knowledge and insights on the Indian governance structures to design a course that blends the use of theory and practice to offer actionable learning outcomes.

The programme will cover topics such as Structure and Framework of Public Policy. Governance in India. Economic Policymaking in India & How does Government decide on investments, in order to provide participants with a holistic view of various facets of policy making, pertaining to the government specifically.

This Executive Education programme is aimed at building local capacity in effective policy formulation and implementation amongst public policy/government relations divisions of large corporates, business unit heads of smaller corporates, heads of NGOs and think tanks, heads of academic institutions, representatives from industry associations and associations of civil society.
